

PROFESSOR PADMANABH S. JAINI

Professor Jaini is a scholar of Jainism and Buddhism, who, although born in a Digambara family, is equally familiar with both the Digambara and Svetambara forms of Jainism. He has taught at the Banaras Hindu University, the School of Oriental and African Studies, the University of Michigan at Ann Arbor and at the University of California at Berkeley, from where he retired in 1994.

Professor Jaini is the author of several books and papers. Perhaps his best known work is the *Jaina Path of Purification* (1979). Some of his major articles have been published under titles: the *Collected Papers on Jaina Studies* (2000) and *Collected Papers on Buddhist Studies* (2001).
