

HUSTON SMITH

Huston Smith is an eminent scholar of world's religions and the author of The World's Religions (original title: The Religions of Man) which has sold over 2.4 million copies, making it the most widely read book on world religions. He has taught at Washington University, MIT, Syracuse University, and the University of California at Berkeley. Bill Moyers developed in 1996 a five-part PBS special called *The Wisdom of Faith with Huston Smith* devoted to his life and work. A recent work to which the author attaches considerable significance is his book entitled Why Religion Matters.
